Rental Eligibility Requirements

1. The applicant must be a Prairie Band Potawatomi Nation tribal member. If at any time the home is not occupied by at least one adult (at least 18 years of age) member of the Prairie Band Potawatomi Nation, the lease will terminate with a minimum 30-day notice.
2. The applicant's household income (after tax and other statutory withholdings) must be adequate to support a reasonable rental payment:
 - a. Rental rates for land acquisition homes will be based on the purchase price of the home as follows:

\$65,000 - \$99,999	=	\$400.00 monthly rent
\$100,000 - \$134,999	=	\$450.00 monthly rent
\$135,000 - \$169,999	=	\$500.00 monthly rent
\$170,000 - \$199,999	=	\$550.00 monthly rent
\$200,000 - \$230,000	=	\$600.00 monthly rent
 - b. Rental rates for Low-Income Tax Credit Housing will not exceed \$250.00 and eligibility will be based on HUD median income guidelines in accordance with Low-Income Housing Tax Credit regulations.
 - c. Rental rates for all other rental properties will be based on income and determined by a sliding scale
3. Applicants must not have had any past due debts owed to or have had a debt forgiven by the Prairie Band Potawatomi Nation or the Prairie Band Potawatomi Housing Department.
4. Applicants are ineligible for this program if they have previously received tribally funded housing assistance consisting of Down Payment Assistance or Renovation/Repair Assistance within the last three (3) years.
5. Applicants are not eligible to rent tribal housing if they own or have an interest in and right to occupy any other residential property.
6. Applicants and potential residents must have a background that indicates they will be able to live harmoniously in the community without presenting a danger to the health and safety of other residents, including a criminal history the does NOT include any of the following:
 - Conviction for murder or attempted murder, manslaughter, rape, attempted rape, kidnapping or attempted kidnapping, or incest within the last 5 years.
 - Conviction for assault with a dangerous weapon, arson, drug manufacturing or distribution/sale within the last 5 years.
 - Conviction for assault and battery, drug possession or use within the last 2 years

7. Applicants and potential residents must have a rental history that indicates they will occupy Tribal Housing in a manner that is consistent with desirable tenants. Applicants may be denied due to any of the following findings on their rental screening application:
 - a. Amounts owed for unpaid rents or damages
 - b. History of damages at previous properties
 - c. Omission or falsification of application information

8. Priority assignment of rental housing will be based on time and date application is received in the Housing Office. Applications will be processed according to qualifying information provided on initial application and type of housing (i.e Land Acquisition, Tax Credit, HUD, etc.) available to applicant based on this qualifying information at the time the application comes up for consideration. (NOTE: all applications will be time and date stamped and initialed by Housing Staff upon receipt.)
